Help Me Grow Kentucky is a statewide FREE helpline designed to connect healthcare providers and their patients, birth through age five, to information about community resources and child development

Help Me Grow Kentucky (HMGKY) is a simple solution that builds on existing resources

- HMGKY offers a FREE family helpline designed by a pediatrician as a central access point for families, medical providers and community service providers.
- HMGKY is an efficient and effective system that not only assists in identifying at-risk children, birth through age five, but also helps families find community-based programs and services.
- HMGKY does not provide direct services. It is a system allowing you to follow the American Academy of Pediatricians recommendation that all infants and young children be screened for delays as a regular part of their ongoing health care.

Why use HMGKY?

- Allows more time to address your patients' health issues by saving time administering and scoring developmental/behavioral screening and researching resources.
- Provides a more efficient system of developmental/behavioral screening by using the evidence-based, family-friendly, Ages & Stages Questionnaires® (ASQ™) to identify delays.
- Keeps you informed by sending notification about the resources where your patients were referred.

Benefits of using the Ages and Stages Questionnaires®

- Easy to use: Each questionnaire is written in simple terms for a parent/guardian (English/Spanish) to complete in about 15 minutes.
- Tracking abilities: Monitor how your patient's developmental progress through continued surveillance.
- Parent education: As parent/guardian completes the ASQ, he/she learns about the child's development.
- Easy to integrate: It's simple and quick to incorporate HMGKY into your office!





How Help Me Grow Kentucky works

- HMGKY is a simple and FREE helpline for families and health providers, offering developmental screening, connection to local services and activities that support healthy growth for children, ages 0-5. It is a partnership with the American Academy of Pediatrics.
- Through physician and community outreach and centralized call center and information, families are linked with needed programs
 and services. Ongoing data collection and analysis helps identify gaps and barriers to the system.

Screens

HMGKY saves screening and assessment time by conducting the developmental screens and referring children with recognized challenges.

Educates

HMGKY educates communities on the importance of early detection of developmental delays in children through screenings.

Connects

By being a central access point for families health care providers, and service providers, HMGKY enhances the connection and promotes awareness between agencies

Improves

HMGKY improves health outcomes and school readiness through linkages to community-based programs and services that address the families' needs.

AAP Guidelines

The American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) recommends the use of surveillance at all well-child visits and the use of a formal screening tools at 9, 18 and 24 (30) month well child visits.
