Meeting Notes

Our 2 topics for this meeting were SOS International and LAMP (Louisville Asthma Management Program) of the LMDPHW.

SOS International <https://soshealthandhope.org/> denise.sears@soshealthandhope.org

- Founded in 1993 and distributes 500-650,000 pounds of medical supplies a year
- Nationally accredited
- 2024 distributed to 234 local partners and 35 counties, including reaching 26,000 students who were able to use the donated supplies for hands on education and training
- Their support led to a town in Ghana being able to open a hospital
- Climate action impact: keeps supplies out of landfills, the health sector has a large carbon foot print much of which is what we throw away that could be donated
- Action:
 1. collect and donate expired or unused supplies to SOS--a large volume from hospitals can be donated but even outpatient areas can donate supplies
 2. volunteer at SOS helping to sort and box up the donated supplies
 3. donate financially to support their work

- LAMP is a FREE Healthy Homes program for children and youth with asthma, focused on trigger reduction and environmental issues (not clinical)
- Criteria: 4 through 18 years old with asthma and live in Louisville Metro; future criteria may include prior ER visit, but not required at this time
- Goals: decrease asthma impact, reduce school absences and reduce ER visits and hospitalizations
- Program: CHW's make home visits, educate families about environmental issues related to asthma, may give resources like a vacuum, cleaning supplies, mattress covers depending on supply. Families can choose to meet at a public space if they do not want a home visit.

- Action:
 1. Refer families to LAMP via email above, email for information, referrals forms/fliers attached here.
 2. Ask your local health department if they have a Health Homes program if you live outside of Louisville Metro

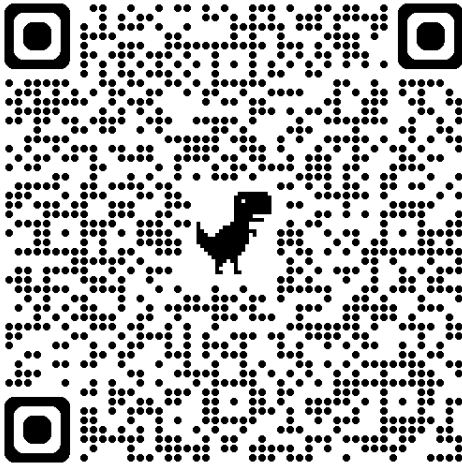

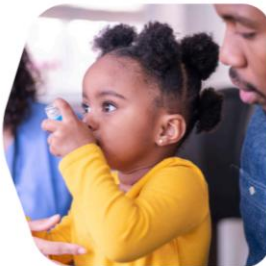
